You will find our staff to be courteous and sympathetic, and our services handled with the utmost compassion and deepest respect. We pay attention to every detail and offer a wide range of prices. We will handle everything possible for you during a most difficult time. We will contact Clergy, order flowers, place newspaper notices, make arrangements with the cemetery, assist with proper clothing selection, secure certified copies of the death certificate, coordinate reservations for a repast, and even make arrangements for people coming from out of town. We try to anticipate your every need.

At our Funeral Home, only licensed funeral directors, taking great personal care, prepare a loved one for the funeral service. We feel that the appearance of a deceased loved one is extremely important, so we make every effort to be the very best in our profession. We encourage every family to share thoughts and ideas with us so that we can arrange a service that is meaningful, resulting in a perfect tribute.

After a death there may be automobile title transfers, life insurance claims, and other forms that need to be notarized. As part of our personal and professional service, we offer to handle all of this at no extra charge. Families we serve will receive free notary service at any time.

We will assist with the application for and notification of Social Security, Veterans Administration, Veterans Affairs, Personnel Departments and Fraternal Organizations for any benefits you may be entitled to receive. At your request, we will even handle life insurance claims.

Provisions for payment are due at the time of arrangements. To avoid the possibility of misunderstanding or embarrassment, and for your convenience, we accept all of the following methods of payment: Checks (personal or cashier's), Visa, Mastercard, Discover, American Express, Assignment of a Verifiable Insurance Policy, Advance Payment by a Forwarding or Receiving Funeral Home, Advance Payment by a Prepaid Funeral Trust Account or Burial Insurance, and Cash.

The goods and services shown below are those we can provide our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral services and merchandise you selected.

An itemized statement of funeral goods and services you selected will be prepared for you. A deposit of at least one half of the funeral expenses is required at the time of arrangements. The balance is due and payable in thirty days.

PROFESSIONAL SERVICES:

BASIC SERVICES OF FUNERAL DIRECTOR AND STAFF. \$1795.00

Our professional service charge includes but is not limited to: responding to initial request for service; conducting the arrangement conference; preparation of biological and statistical data; examination of financial settlement options; preparation and filing of necessary papers, permits, and authorizations; coordination with those providing other services, e.g. clergy, cemetery, crematory, and others; preparation and placement of obituary notices; retention and care of remains prior to commencement of post death activities.

The fee for our services will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you selected. This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and the forwarding or receiving of remains.

EMBALMING (Standard) \$950.00

EMBALMING (Autopsy) \$1050.00

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement which does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial. (The fee for the use of the preparation room is already included in this charge.) *No human remains may remain unburied or uncremated in New Jersey for more than 48 hours unless embalmed or refrigerated. (N.J.A.C. 8:9-1.1) *If you choose to have an embalming performed, the decedent may be embalmed at a location other than this registered mortuary.*

SPECIAL SERVICES OF FUNERAL DIRECTOR \$275.00

This charge is per hour for such services as accompaniment of remains to final disposition, out of town charges, attendance at a memorial service, or requests for services not normally considered a standard part of selected services.

SANITARY CARE WITHOUT EMBALMING \$295.00

This fee includes the charge for the preparation room.

CASH DISBURSMENTS: This list does not include prices for certain items that you may ask us to purchase for you, such as cemetery charges or crematory services, flowers and newspaper notices. The prices for those items will be shown on your bill or the statement describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

The cost of the grave space, the opening of the grave and the perpetual care of the grave is determined by the cemetery you select. They are also given authority to require the use of outer burial containers as well as the type of memorial you select.

DEATH NOTICES are considered a classified ad; a “per line” fee will be incurred. Please be advised that papers have a higher rate in the areas of higher newspaper distribution.

OBITUARIES are considered a “news items,” and although they contain a more informative profile of the deceased, the content of the obituary is determined by the newspaper editors. Spelling is not guaranteed and the placement is subject to availability of space.

FORWARDING REMAINS TO ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME:from \$2295.00

This package includes local removal of remains to our funeral home, basic services of funeral director and staff, basic sheltering of remains, embalming, and obtaining necessary permits. This price does not include transportation charges involved in the transfer from one funeral home to the other. It also does not include a casket or container which may be required to make the transfer possible, nor does it include anything not expressly stated as being provided.

RECEIVING REMAINS FROM ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME: from \$1620.00

This package includes receiving the remains from another funeral home, basic sheltering of remains, basic services of funeral director and staff, the obtaining of necessary permits and authorizations, and local transportation to cemetery or crematory. This price does not include transportation charges involved in the transfer from one funeral home to the other, the use of the funeral home for visitation and services, the cemetery or crematory charges, a casket or container for transfer or final disposition, nor does it include anything not expressly stated as being provided.

DIRECT CREMATION: from \$1895.00 to \$15,395.00

Our package charges for direct cremation include basic services of funeral director and staff, the local (within 10 miles) transfer of remains to funeral home, the basic sheltering of the remains, the obtaining of necessary permits and authorizations, local transportation to the crematory, sanitary care and preparations of remains for identification. This charge does not include the use of facilities and staff for any visitation or ceremony, public or private, prior to cremation, or any sheltering for days on which no post death activities occur. Nor does it include the actual cost of the cremation process, which is a crematory charge, or any other cash disbursements, or anything not expressly stated as being provided.

If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering)

The containers we provide are constructed of fiberboard and cardboard.

IMMEDIATE BURIAL: from \$2220.00 to \$22,220

Our package charges for immediate burial include basic services of funeral director and staff, the local (within 10 miles) transfer of remains to the funeral home, the basic sheltering of the remains, the obtaining of necessary permits and authorizations, local transportation to the cemetery, sanitary care and preparations of remains for identification. This charge does not include the use of facilities and staff for any visitation or ceremony, public or private, prior to burial, or any sheltering for days on which no post death activities occur. Nor does it include the actual cost of the grave at the cemetery, or the cemetery's charges for opening and closing of the grave, any required outer burial container or cash disbursements, or anything not expressly stated as being provided.
